Known throughout the process industries as a gifted communicator on safety matters, Dr. Kletz has wide knowledge of both practice and theory. He joined Imperial Chemical Industries after graduating as a chemist and spent eight years in research, sixteen production management, and the last fourteen as safety advisor to the Petrochemical Division.

On retiring from ICI after 38 years of service, he joined Loughborough University Technology, at first full-time and then from 1986 as a Visiting Fellow. He has written ten books, more than 100 papers, and over 300 articles on process safety and loss prevention. He is a Fellow of the Royal Academy of Engineering, the Institution of Chemical Engineers and the Royal Society of Chemistry.
